From Vicar's Desk

Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

–(Philippians 4:6-7)

Dearly Beloved in Christ,

Most of our worry and anxiety come from focusing on circumstances, problems, and the “what ifs” of this life. Granted, it’s true that some anxiety is physiological in nature and may require medical treatment, but the everyday anxiety that most believers deal with is generally rooted in this one thing: unbelief.

George Mueller, the 19th-century evangelist, was known as a man of great faith and prayer. He said, “The beginning of anxiety is the end of faith, and the beginning of true faith is the end of anxiety.” It has also been said that worry is unbelief in disguise.

Jesus Christ presents us with the cure for anxiety: faith in God (Matthew 6:25-34). Jesus could have summed up the whole lesson with these two sentences: “Cast all of your anxiety on God the Father. Show you trust him by bringing everything to him in prayer.”

The Apostle Peter said, “Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.” (1 Peter 5:7) The word “cast” means to throw. We throw off our cares and toss them onto God’s big shoulders. God himself will take care of our needs. We throw our cares on God through prayer. The book of James tells us that the prayers of believers are powerful and effective: “Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.” (James 5:16)

The Apostle Paul taught the Philippians that prayer cures anxiety. According to Paul in our key verse (Philippians 4:6-7), our prayers ought to be filled with thanksgiving and gratitude. God answers these kinds of prayers with his supernatural peace. When we trust God with every care and concern, he invades us with divine peace. It’s the kind of peace we can’t understand, but it protects our hearts and minds--from anxiety.

Have you ever noticed how worry and anxiety drain your strength?

You lay awake at night burdened with concerns. Instead, when worries begin to fill your mind, place those troubles in God's capable hands. The Lord will tend to your concerns by either meeting the need or giving you something better. God's sovereignty means our prayers can be answered far beyond even what we can ask or imagine: "Now all glory to God, who is able, through his mighty power at work within us, to accomplish infinitely more than we might ask or think." (Ephesians 3:20)

Take a moment to recognize your anxiety for what it really is--a symptom of unbelief. Remember that the Lord knows your needs and sees your circumstances. He is with you now, walking through your trials with you, and he holds your tomorrow securely in his grip. Turn to God in prayer and trust in him completely. This is the only lasting cure for anxiety.

May God Almighty provide you all a prosperous and blessed new year!

He told the congregation that how the church in the early years comprised of 40 male & 10 female members with an offertory of Rs. 7.47.

The year 2020 will be an year of reckoning for our Church and Our Thirumeni will be elevated to more respected and responsible positions in our Church. Parish whole-heartedly pray that Thirumeni's leadership will bring a fresh awakening and a new hope to the Church in the glory of God. Our Parish celebrated its Harvest Festival - "In gathering 2019" on November 24th, 2019 immediately after service. The theme was "Bring an Item, Bid for one". The church members heeded this call and came in large numbers with their offerings. The Ingathering team worked hard to make all the arrangements in time to kick start the gathering immediately after service.

The Ingathering team had the monumental target of a collection of Rs 10 Lakhs. Assistance was given to families who faced challenges in getting their offerings to Church. The committee members gave an extended support by fetching items from them and getting it to Church. Additionally, there was a screen projecting the Live Auction details.

For the first time a lucky draw was conducted. This kept people

curious till the end and fetched an additional INR 1 lakh. We place on record our appreciation to Mr. John Joseph for sponsoring the gold coin for the lucky draw.

We had 236 items brought for the auction by 117 families. We also had 81 families making at least one bid. In all we had the participation of 121 families.

The church recognizes the efforts of our tireless auctioneers: Mr. V.S. Varghese & Mr. Menin Daniel who conducted the proceeding flawlessly in the most engaging manner.

The Ingathering team consisting of Mr. John George, Mr. Mathews Jacob, Mr. C. Kunjumon, Mr. Mon Varghese, Mr. Alex Daniel, Mr. Thomas Varghese need a special mention for ensuring the smooth proceedings.

Since the last update in our quarterly magazine Nadham, we have paid one more installment of Rs. 25 lakhs in the 2nd week of November, 2019. With this payment, we have paid a total of Rs. 1 Crore and 9 Lakhs to the seller till date.

Now we require 75 lakhs more to complete the transaction with the next installment due in January, 2020. Thereafter, we intend to pay off the remaining dues before the end of this financial year and register the land in our favor.

It is heartening to note the response from members of our Church in raising funds and their desire to conclude the deal at the

earliest. Every organization in the church is striving to collect funds for the purpose. The efforts made by Sevika Sangham in donating Rs. One lakh is an example of their devotion to the cause.

For this, we need to work together as a team. Each one has a responsibility to reach out to those who have not contributed with their one-month’s income, and to our friends and relatives who were members of our Parish earlier, and to the children of our members who are working abroad. We can easily achieve the target amount once we commit ourselves for this purpose.

We trust in the Lord to guide us in our efforts to complete the land purchase deal and move forward in building a project which the members will be ever proud of.

30th Episcopal Consecration Anniversary and Thanksgiving – Prof KC Abraham

The 30th Episcopal Consecration Anniversary and Thanksgiving Function was held at St John's MTC Khadki on 7th December 2019 to honor Rt. Rev. Dr. Geevarghese Mar Theodosius, Episcopa of Mumbai Diocese. The program was organized by Mumbai Diocese and hosted by Pune Centre parishes.

It was a really a blessed afternoon wherein thousands of believers from Pune, Mumbai, Goa, Gujarat converged in at St. John's MTC to felicitate Mar Theodosius Thirumeni. His Grace the Most Rev. Dr. Joseph Mar Thoma Metropolitan was present to preside over the function. The other dignitaries who graced

the occasion included Most Rev. Geevarghese Mar Coorilos Metropolitan (Mumbai Diocese Orthodox Syrian Church), Most Rev. Dr. Thomas Mar Anthonios OIC (Syro Malankara Catholic church), Rt. Rev. Dr. Thomas Dabre (Bishop of Catholic Church, Pune Diocese), Vicar General Very Rev. Varghese Mattamana, and a galaxy of clergy from different denominations from Mumbai and Pune, Sabha Council members of Mumbai Diocese and Diocesan Council members

Rt. Rev. Geevarghese Mar Theodosius and other dignitaries were welcomed to the beautiful "Shore of thanksgiving" by children from Immanuel MT

School, Vishrantwadi who gave a traditional Maharashtrian welcome, wearing band attire and playing lezim in tune with the drum beats. Members of different organizations from parishes of Pune Center greeted the dignitaries by spreading rose petals. The function opened with a prayer by Rev. memoir, compiled by the Pune center, in honor of Thirumeni was released. It captures the experiences of people from different walks of life with Thirumeni in his mission work and ministry days. His commitment and administration were highlighted.

Also, a Festschrift volume, "Beyond homogeneity: Identities, Mission and resurgent Fundamentalism" in honor of Rt Rev. Dr. Geevarghese Mar Theodosius was released by the Metropolitan.

A documentary on Mar Theodosius Thirumeni by Rev. Benoy J. Thomas was screened.

Prizes were distributed to the winners of essay competition held on occasion of the 30th anniversary of Episcopal Consecration. Annual Eco awards instituted by Mumbai diocese were also presented. Youth from St. Thomas MTC Pimpri presented a choreography about the importance of accepting the transgenders "I'm Strong When I'm your Shoulder" followed by a song.

Theodosius thirumeni in his response spoke about advent 2020 which is going to be a milestone for Malabar Syrian Mar Thoma Church and wished the Metropolitan who is entering Navathy next year. Mar Theodosius described the collaborations as a humbling experience and requested the continued love and prayers from all. He expressed solidarity with

the oppressed fighting for justice, for the poor, hungry, thirsty and forsaken to express their love of Christ to others. He reminded that the Christ had emptied himself on the cross. Rev. C. John the General Convener expressed thanks to all those who have attended the

function for making it memorable. The function concluded with a prayer by Mr. O. V. Mathew and benediction by the Metropolitan followed by the National Anthem. The function was very ably anchored by Krupa and Thomas Alexander.
